## PAYING TRIBUTE TO A KIWANIS CLUB OF CAREFREE MEMBER

Rose Marie (Funaro) Maher, a longtime resident of Carefree, Arizona, died Tuesday, September 28, 2021. She was 84 years old, with the spirit and will of a much younger woman.
