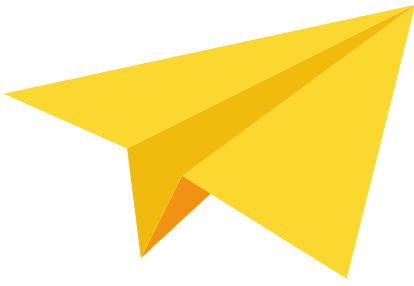

SKYWARD YOUTH AVIATION

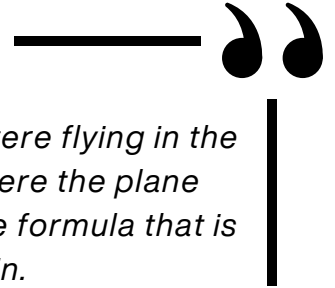
