FOOTHILLS FOOD BANK

Kiwanis has recently awarded a major grant to the Foothills Food Bank to address the urgent issue of childhood hunger by providing essential nutrition to students facing food insecurity when school meal programs are unavailable over the weekend. Every week during the academic year, the Foothills Food Bank distributes discrete, pre-packaged bags containing two breakfasts, two lunches, two dinners, and a variety of nutritious snacks to children identified by school staff as food-insecure. This program ensures that no child has to face a weekend wondering when they'll eat next.


